Required Lower Division Courses (7 units)

- (1) JOUR 20 Style for Media Writers
- (3) JOUR 30 News Writing (JOUR 20)
- (3) JOUR 50 Mass Media and Critical Thinking **OR**
JOUR 55 Media Communication and Society

Required Upper Division Courses (18 units)

- (3) JOUR 128 Copy Editing and Ethics (JOUR 30)
- (3) JOUR 130A News Reporting I (JOUR 20; JOUR 30; Corequisite: JOUR 130B)
- (3) JOUR 130B News Reporting II (JOUR 20; JOUR 30; Corequisite JOUR 130A)
- (3) JOUR 135 Public Affairs Reporting (JOUR 130A; JOUR 130B)
- (3) JOUR 153 Mass Media Law and Regulation

Select **one** of the following:

- JOUR 195 Internship in Journalism (JOUR 130A; JOUR 130B)
- (3) JOUR 197A Journalism Laboratory (JOUR 30)
- (3) JOUR 197B Journalism Laboratory (JOUR 30; instructor permission)

Electives (12 units)

Upper division Journalism courses selected in consultation with your major advisor

At least 9 of the 12 units must be upper division. No more than a total of nine units in JOUR 195/JOUR 197A/JOUR 197B/JOUR 198/JOUR 199 combined may be counted toward the major, and no more than 6 units on any one of these courses is counted toward the major.

Note: The Journalism major requires a minor -- to be chosen in consultation with your major advisor.
